\*In the Masters age group, athletes compete in two age classifications. A Master is defined as a rower who is 27 years or older in 2024 and who has not been a member of the national team or participated in national or international competitions as a national team member in 2024. For Masters, an age time adjustment of 0.8 seconds per year is applied.

\*\*A team for the team event classification must consist of four athletes, including at least one female athlete, all representing the same club or school.
